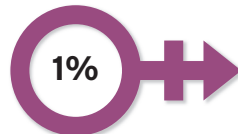

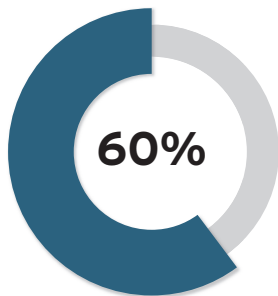

**Chronically Homeless**

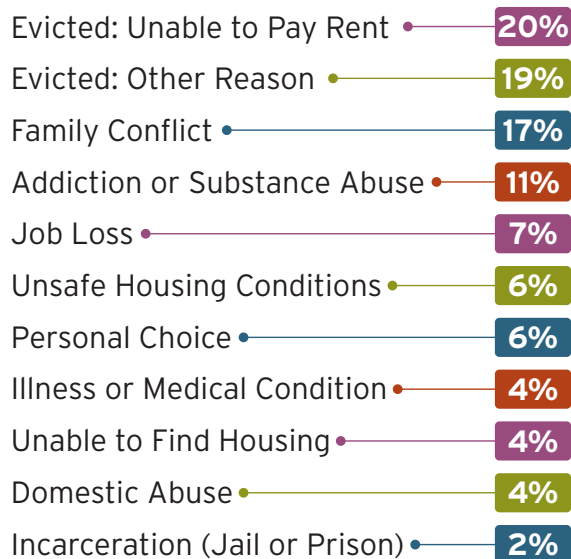
homeless for 6 months or more within the past year
